Purpose: Embrace and support the cultivation of independent skills acquired through assistive technology and iPhone training classes.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide support to the Senior Assistive Technology Practitioner and Rehabilitation Staff to ensure students comprehend and are on task with course materials.
- Reinforce course objectives to promote confidence in concepts such as smart phone gestures, keystrokes, and additional assistive technology strategies and procedures related to smartphones and computers.
- Communicate updates to Rehabilitation staff instructors regarding student challenges and achievements.

Qualifications:

- Training or experience in rehabilitation, occupational therapy, education, social services, or computer science.
- Strong familiarity with one or more technology applications and adaptive technologies such as JAWS, Zoomtext, VoiceOver, or TalkBack. Ability to learn additional applications and technologies as needed.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Enjoys working with a diverse population.
- Personal experience with assistive technology preferred.
- Successful completion of a background investigation.

Occurrence:

- Scheduled 8 week and 5 week sessions as arranged through Rehabilitation Staff Supervisors. Common Class times for sessions will occur:
 - Monday's 10-12p and 1-3p through April 2 (iPhone Training Classes)
 - Tuesday's and Thursday's 8:30a-10a (JAWS Computer Classes)
