### **Cleveland Sight Center Launches Redesigned Website**

**Cleveland, OH - 3/18/2015** - Cleveland Sight Center (CSC) is proud to announce the launch of the newly redesigned [clevelandsightcenter.org](http://clevelandsightcenter.org), a website dedicated to increasing awareness and support of the education, empowerment and employment of clients with blindness or low vision.

Together with local marketing agency Level Seven Group, CSC has been able to improve the design and functionality of their website to provide easy accessibility to those who are blind or have low vision. Level Seven added not only a technical, but personal approach to their partnership with CSC in developing this site. Keeping the end-user in mind, they used Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) to develop the site to be tier AA compliant which matches ADA compliance standards. They performed user testing with several types of users to gain feedback about the enhanced user experience.

The new functionality, WCAG compliant, includes hidden elements that allow special instruction for users such as image and video descriptions, provides options for visitors to switch to high contrast or gray scale display or increase site text sizes, and uses updated site navigation, content and search capabilities designed for users visiting the site with assistive technology.
