



Position Title: Golf Assistant

Purpose: To assist a golfer who has limited vision or blindness at the driving range and on the golf course.

Location: Local golf courses and driving ranges. Such as, Washington Park Learning Center, Green Ridge Golf Course, North Olmsted Golf Course and Shawnee Hills Golf Course. Volunteer may select the location that is most convenient to them.

Key Responsibilities:

- Assist golfers as needed
- Ensure safety
- Provide transportation for golfers from course to their homes (as needed)
- Help with address
- Reading the course
- Providing encouragement

Qualifications:

- Volunteer should enjoy golf. However, need not be an experienced golfer. Training may be provided so that volunteers may better assist golfers.
- Successful completion of a background investigation.
- Completion of Cleveland Sight Center Volunteer Orientation.
- Physical Abilities
 - Walk on uneven terrain.
 - Bend or stoop multiple times per shift.
 - Stand for 2 hours or more.
 - Lift and carry full golf bag
 - Drive golf cart
- Access to reliable transportation to golf venues

Commitment:

- Tuesday evenings May through August
- Optional once per month commitment during off season (at Golf Dome in Chagrin Falls).

Age Requirement: Over 16 years old

Dress Code: Golf Attire

Training:

- Volunteer Orientation at Cleveland Sight Center.
- Sighted Guide training for golfers
